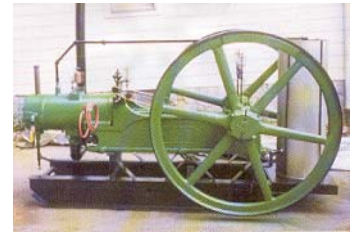

Application for exemption for federal income tax up- date

If this is the case, we will receive a letter stating that we are exempt from federal income tax. If the initial review indicates that additional information or changes are necessary we will be contacted by an Exempt Organization Specialist. Normally, we should hear from them within 120 days.

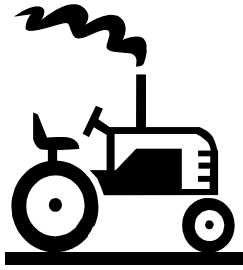

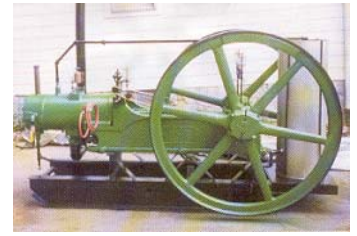

SHOW COMMITTEE

Report... The 2006 Show Committee

Had a meeting January 19. Items of discussion included the following: The club is in need of additional bleachers for the show. Members are encouraged to keep their eyes open for any used bleachers or upcoming surplus auctions. Approved the purchase of 4 additional speakers identical to existing speakers in order to maximize sound during the show and pulls. Water truck is in the process of being built to utilize during the pull. T-shirt orders were discussed and total order amount and sizes were determined. The T-shirts will have two tractors and one engine in the design. The show committee agreed to allow three companies to create a design for the shirts and then choose accordingly once those proposals have been received. The t-shirts will read as follows: Foothills Antique Power Association, NC 3rd Annual 2006, Hickory American Legion Fairgrounds. we will also add the website address on the back of the shirt along with the listing of sponsors. At the request of the membership the T-shirt color will be changed this year from white to either grey or earth-tone. It was decided upon that all members and their immediate family would be available to enter the show at no charge only if they had their membership card. General public admission will be \$5 each day of the show, multiple day discounts have not yet been discussed. The show committee decided to utilize the exhibit hall again this year and the committee was encouraged to be creative on its use in order to generate more traffic through that building. The program will include three tractors on the cover and the membership is encouraged to submit articles of interest for the interior. Sponsorship cut-off date was set for April 25. Lorie Garland submitted a letter that will be mailed to local businesses for their donation. Since the show has been extended to three days there will be a Parade of Power both Saturday and Sunday. The schedule of events was determined and will be shared at the next meeting. The next show committee meeting will be Thursday February 16, 7pm those interested in assisting with the planning process are encouraged to attend.
